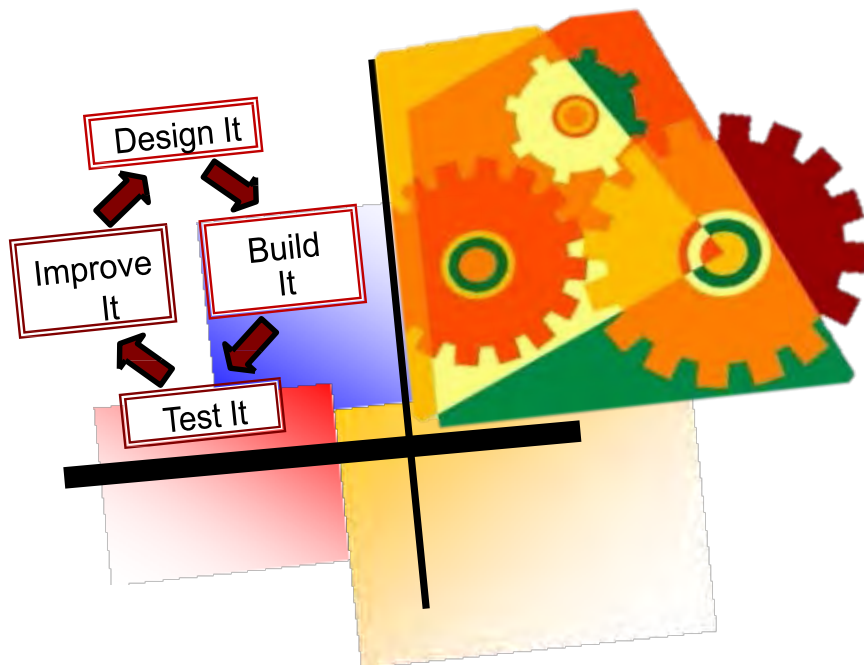

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. **Entry forms should be completed and mailed by September 15, 2017** to Roger Tormoehlen, Purdue University, 225 S. University Street, West Lafayette, IN 47907. A signed Code of Conduct is a part of each entry. Copies of entry forms are enclosed. Complete addresses and telephone numbers are essential. *States selecting delegates after September 15 should indicate tentative participation by September 15 and forward entries as soon as possible.*
2. All contest officials (coaches, chaperones and volunteers) must complete the volunteer registration form. Completed form should be sent to Roger Tormoehlen by September 15.
3. Official state delegation lists are due to Roger Tormoehlen by **September 15**. Workshop reservations and assignment of duties will be made from this list.
4. Educational workshops/tours have been arranged for Tuesday, September 26. All delegates are expected to participate (except staff representatives attending the Future Plans/Management Committee meeting). **Note:** Industry tours typically do not allow jewelry, or cell phones in the factory and closed-toed shoes will be required; so please plan accordingly.
5. The Management Committee has established registration fees of **\$70.00** for contestant and **\$90.00** for non-contestant. This fee is payable at registration.
6. The Annual Recognition Banquet will be held at The Trails at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 26. All participants, coaches, and other persons composing the delegation from each state are invited to attend.
7. Each participant should bring a raincoat. Appropriate dress for the banquet Tuesday evening would include shirt, tie and coat for the boys and dress or pantsuit for the girls.
8. Each state should arrange for health and accident insurance coverage of delegates in keeping with state policy for delegates participating in out-of-state events. In addition, the event's management committee will purchase an accident/injury policy from American Income Life for all official participants.
