Self-Propelled Agricultural Equipment

Directions: Match the description on the left with the pictured self-propelled agricultural equipment on the right (draw a line). Hint: you may want to visit the glossary.

1. A small, highly-maneuverable front-end loader used to load and transport materials

2. A farm implement used to harvest grass, corn, and other forage crops by chopping the crop into small pieces and blowing it into transport vehicles

3. A large rubber-tired, machine used to drag logs from the forest

4. A machine that has its own power train so that it can be driven through the field in contrast to a pull-type sprayer that must be pulled through the field

5. A machine that cuts, conditions, and gathers a crop (often hay) into long, narrow rows that are later picked up by a harvesting machine, such as a baler or forage harvester

6. A harvesting machine that gathers cotton bolls

7. Designed specially for lifting material stacked on pallets

8. A harvesting machine that threshes and separates seed or grain from the leaves and stems of the crop
